Crochet pattern

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The pattern does not contain crochet lessons, basic crochet skills are required.

Materials and tools:

Yarn: YarnArt Jeans (55% cotton/45% polyacrylic, 50 grams/160 meters)

- 1. 26 Red color, ½ of a skein
- 2. 01 white color, ½ of a skein
- 3.52 green color, a little bit
- 4. Crochet hook size 2 mm
- 5. Crochet hook size 1.5 mm (for leaves and berries)
- 6. Toy filling (hollow fiber)
- 7. Stitch marker
- 8. Long needle for assembly, scissors and safety pins

The height of the toy is about 6 centimeters= 2,36 inches, when listed materials are used and medium tension.

Abbreviations:

MR - magic ring

sc - single crochet

inc – increase (2 sc in one loop)

dec – decrease (crochet 2 sc together)

ch - chain

Slst – slip stitch

hdc - half double crochet

dc - double crochet

- (...) the number inside the brackets indicates the number of stitches in a row
- (...)*N repeat the pattern inside brackets N times

Work in spirals, do not join unless otherwise is indicated.

Skills level - easy.

Enjoy crocheting!

White ornament

With white color yarn

Rnd 1 - 6 sc into MR (6)

Rnd 2 - inc*6 (12)

Rnd $3 - (1 \text{ sc, inc})^* 6 (18)$

place your stitch marker in the first stitch of the round

Rnd 4 - (2 sc, inc) *6 (24)

Rnd 5 - (3 sc, inc) *6 (30)

Rnd 6 – (4 sc, inc) *6 (36)

Rnd 7 - (5 sc, inc) *6 (42)

Rnd 8 - (6 sc, inc) *6 (48)

Rnd 9 - (7 sc, inc) *6 (54) (pic. 1)

Rnd 10-18 – 9 rounds of 54 sc (54) (pic. 2)

Run the yarn through magic ring to make a loop, now it can go on a tree (pic. 3)

Rnd 19 – (7 sc, dec)*6 (48)

Rnd 20 - (6 sc, dec)*6 (42)

Rnd 21 - (5 sc, dec)*6 (36)

Rnd 22 – (4 sc, dec)*6 (30) Start stuffing the piece


Rnd 23 - (3 sc, dec)*6 (24)

Rnd 24 – (2 sc, dec)*6 (18)

Rnd $25 - (1 \text{ sc, dec})^*6 (12)$ Stuff the piece firmly.

Fasten off, leaving long yarn tail. Tighten the hole, using front loops.

Cut the yarn, hide yarn tail inside the piece. (pic. 4)





Berries (work with crochet hook 1.5 mm)

With red color yarn 3 pieces

Rnd 1 - 6 sc into MR (6)

Rnd 2 – inc*6 (12) (pic. 5)


Rnd 3-4 – 12 sc, Slst (12) Stuff the piece slightly. (pic. 6)

Fasten off, leaving long yarn tail.

Tighten the hole, using front loops.

Take yarn tail out of the center of tightened hole. (pic. 7)





Leaves (work with crochet hook 1.5 mm)

With green color yarn 3 pieces


Rnd 1 – make 10 ch (10) (pic. 9)

Rnd 2 - from the second loop from the hook 1 sc, 1 sc, 1 hdc, 1 dc, 2 dc in one loop,

1 dc, 1 hdc, 1 sc, 3 sc into the last loop, 1 sc, 1 hdc, 1 dc, 2 dc in one loop,

1 dc, 1 hdc, 2 sc (21) (pic. 10)

Rnd 3 – Slst, [(work in one stitch 1 sc, 1 dc, 1 sc), Slst, Slst]*7 (pic. 11-12)



Now let's make a stem of the leaf Start by making ch 4 (pic.13), from the second loop from the hook 1 Slst, 2 Slst, connect leaf with stem with slst (pic. 14) Fasten off, leaving long yarn tail.



Assembly.

Sew leaves to the top of the ornament with 2-3 stitches. Sew the end of the leaf as well, with 2-3 stitches. (pic. 15-17)



Using remaining yarn tail, sew berries to leaves. (pic. 18-20)



Red ornament

With red color yarn

Rnd 1 - 6 sc into MR (6)

Rnd 2 – inc*6 (12)

Rnd $3 - (1 \text{ sc, inc})^* 6 (18)$

place your stitch marker in the first stitch of the round

Rnd 4 - (2 sc, inc) *6 (24)

Rnd 5 - (3 sc, inc) *6 (30)

Rnd 6 – (4 sc, inc) *6 (36)

Rnd 7 – (5 sc, inc) *6 (42)

Rnd 8 - (6 sc, inc) *6 (48)

Rnd 9 - (7 sc, inc) *6 (54) (pic 21)

Rnd 10-18 - 9 rounds of 54 sc (54) (pic. 22)

Run the yarn through magic ring to make a loop, now it can go on a tree (pic. 23)

Rnd 19 – (7 sc, dec)*6 (48)

Rnd 20 – (6 sc, dec)*6 (42)

Rnd 21 – (5 sc, dec)*6 (36)

Rnd $22 - (4 \text{ sc, dec})^*6 (30)$ Start stuffing the piece

Rnd 23 - (3 sc, dec)*6 (24)


Rnd 24 – (2 sc, dec)*6 (18)


Rnd 25 – $(1 \text{ sc, dec})^*6$ (12) Stuff the piece firmly.

Fasten off, leaving long yarn tail.

Tighten the hole, using front loops.

Cut the yarn, hide yarn tail inside the piece. (pic. 24)





Berries (work with crochet hook 1.5 mm)

With white color yarn 3 pieces

Rnd 1 - 6 sc into MR (6)

Rnd 2 – inc*6 (12) (pic. 25)

Rnd 3-4 – 12 sc, Slst (12) Stuff the piece slightly. (pic. 26)

Fasten off, leaving long yarn tail.

Tighten the hole, using front loops.

Take yarn tail out of the center of tightened hole. (pic. 27)



Small leaf (work with crochet hook1.5 mm)

With green color yarn 1 pieces

Rnd 1 – make 10 ch (10) (pic. 28)

Rnd 2 - from the second loop from the hook 1 sc, 1 sc, 1 hdc, 1 dc, 2 dc in one loop,

1 dc, 1 hdc, 1 sc, 3 sc into the last loop, 1 sc, 1 hdc, 1 dc, 2 dc in one loop,

1 dc, 1 hdc, 2 sc (21) (pic. 29)

Fasten off, leaving long yarn tail.






Big leaves (work with crochet hook 1.5 mm)

With green color yarn 2 pieces

Rnd 1 – make 12 ch (12) (pic. 30)

Rnd 2 - from the second loop from the hook 1 sc, 1 sc, 1 hdc, 1 dc, (2 dc in one loop)*3, 1 dc, 1 hdc, 1 sc, 3 sc into the last loop, 1 sc, 1 hdc, 1 dc, (2 dc in one loop)*3, 1 dc, 1 hdc, 2 sc (29) (pic. 31)






Now we will start working on a stem
Start by making ch 4 (pic. 32), then from the second loop from the hook 1 Slst,
2 Slst (pic. 33) and connect the stem with the leaf with slst. (pic. 34)
Fasten off, leaving long yarn tail.



Assembly.

Sew leaves to the top of the ornament with 2-3 stitches. Sew the end of the leaf as well, with 2-3 stitches. (pic. 35-37)



Using remaining yarn tail, sew berries to leaves. (pic. 38-40)



Your christmas tree ornaments are finished!
